Reciprocity Agreement between the Irish Mathematical Society and the Moscow Mathematical Society

This agreement is aimed at the establishment of good scientific relations between the two Societies in order to facilitate the exchange of useful information between them.

The agreement between the Societies

In accordance with all bylaws and regulations governing both Societies, and after consultation and approval of their respective governing bodies, the President of the Irish Mathematical Society and the President of the Moscow Mathematical Society hereby sign this reciprocity agreement.

1. The Societies agree to exchange their publications in a timely manner either in hard or electronic format until further notice:

The Irish Mathematical Society will post or send by e-mail one copy of the *Irish Mathematical Society Bulletin* and any other publications it may produce to a designated address in Moscow, given by the Moscow Mathematical Society.

The Moscow Mathematical Society will post or send by e-mail one copy of the Russian Mathematical Surveys ("Uspekhi") and any other publications it may produce to a designated address in Ireland, given by the Irish Mathematical Society.

- 2. The Societies also agree to facilitate the exchange of invited researchers and graduate students between both Societies and to exchange invitations for all relevant activities organized by each Society.
- 3. The terms of this agreement may be changed at any time by mutual consent of the two Societies. This agreement may be terminated at any time by a simple request from one of the two Societies, provided this course of action has the approval of the appropriate governing bodies and is communicated as early as possible.
- 4. The Irish Mathematical Society recognizes to all full members of the Moscow Mathematical Society in good standing, the right to become Reciprocity Members of the Irish Mathematical Society provided that he/she is not normally resident in Ireland. The reciprocity membership fee will be equivalent to 50% of the annual fee charged to full members of the Irish Mathematical Society.
- 5. The Moscow Mathematical Society recognizes to all full members of the Irish Mathematical Society in good standing, the right to become Reciprocity Members of the Moscow Mathematical Society provided that he/she is not normally resident in Russia. The reciprocity membership fee will be equivalent to 50% of the annual fee charged to full members of the Moscow Mathematical Society.

Additional Note. The reciprocity memberships as detailed in paragraphs 4 and 5 above are suspended until a satisfactory solution to the payment of membership fees to/from Moscow is established.

This agreement is signed by the Presidents of both Societies in the cities of Belfast (Northern Ireland) on 30/1/14 and Moscow (Russia) on 29/1/14, respectively.
